- IV Catheters are used to administer medication directly to your pet's bloodstream. They are an easy access portal especially in emergency cases and prevent needle stick injuries.

- It is recommended to use IV fluids during anesthetic/sedative procedures as they aid in keeping your pet hydrated and maintain their blood pressure.

SCROTAL ABLATION (MALE DOGS ONLY): \$220.00

- You know your pet best, if you know that your pet has an excessive amount of energy and loves to run/jump or play rough please consider this option for your pet. Neuters are a routine procedure, but every now and then we do have some patients return to us because their extreme energy led to a swollen scrotum. The procedure involves the complete removal of the testicles along with the scrotum.

- If you elect to decline the Scrotal Ablation you understand that complications may arise including but not limited to scrotal swelling, hemorrhage, bruising, and scrotal hematoma. These complications may result in the need for surgical repair with ranging cost of \$600 to \$1000.

PROTECTIVE COLLARS

- Collars are very helpful in preventing the patient from chewing or licking at the incision site during their recovery. Chewing or licking at the incision can cause damage to the tissue around the site and may cause bleeding or removal of the sutures which can be a major complication should the internal organs be exposed. Please note there will be additional charges for any additional surgical care of post-op complications.
