



Rescue Group Protocols:

- All rescues are to pay off entire invoices the same day that all services are provided. Rescue groups are not allowed to carry a bill.
- Our canine spay/neuter price of \$87 is for patients 3 years old and under. The patient must be under 60 lbs for the price to stay at \$87. If the patient is over 60 lbs, \$1.50/lb will be added to the spay/neuter charge. Canines over the age of 3 must be brought in for a consult with our veterinarians before the spay/neuter procedure can be scheduled.
- Feline spays are \$64 and neuters are \$40. We ask that they be 2.5+ lbs in order for us to spay/neuter them.
- We do not handle feral cats, this is for the safety of our staff.
- There is a \$10/week pregnancy charge added on for any feline/canine spay. If it's discovered that the patient is pregnant we will call the rescue coordinator responsible for making medical decisions and ask them if they would like for us to continue with the procedure or not.
- All canines must have 2 distemper/parvo vaccinations given by a licensed veterinarian in order to have a spay/neuter performed at our clinic. We do not accept feed store or any other vaccines not given by a licensed veterinarian. This is to protect our clinic and staff as we do not know if vaccines given by anyone other than a licensed veterinarian have been properly given or properly stored. Nor do we know where these vaccines are coming from.
- We ask that in the event you need to schedule appointments with us for exams or vaccines that your fosters bring in no more than 5 pets at a time. In the event that your group needs to bring in more than 5 pets, please schedule an appointment with us no later than 4 pm. Our veterinarians are here from 8 am – 10 am & 2 pm – 5 pm, Mondays – Fridays. From 10 am – 2 pm we are in surgery.
- No more than 2 pets can be scheduled per procedure for surgeries a day (2 canine spays, 2 canine neuters, 2 feline spays, 2 feline neuters, 2 dentals) this includes other major surgeries (mass removals, laceration repairs, foreign body removals, amputations, etc..)
- All patients requiring a dental or major surgery must come in for a consult before the procedure can be scheduled.
